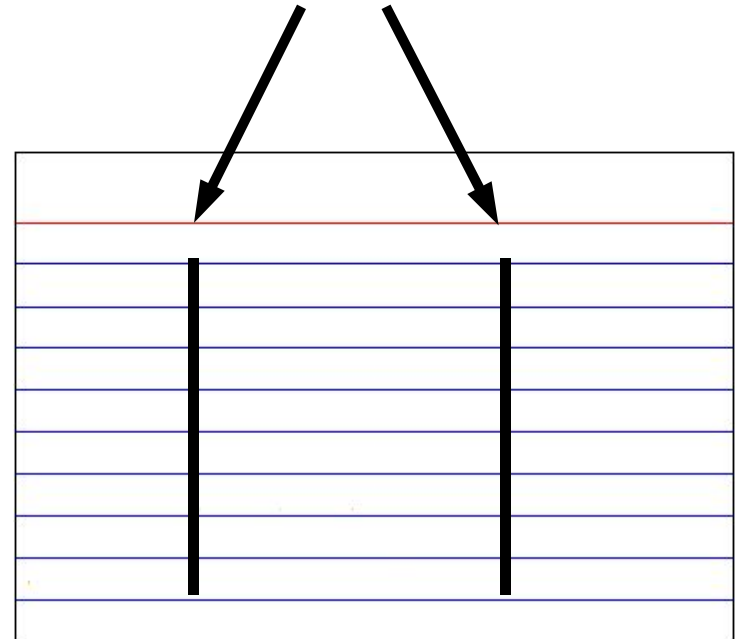


1. Go To Pikistrips.com
2. Sign up for an account
3. Follow online instructions and complete your comic strip.
4. When done, choose preview, if it looks good, press save.
5. Give it a title, add a description and tags, press save again.
6. On the next page, find the download button.
7. Download to your computer in a file that you can easily find.
8. Open the Pikistrip in Microsoft Publisher, just like below, resizing to fit your needs.
9. Use the crop tool to isolate just your comic strip.
10. Print page.
11. Cut out the comic.
12. Accordion Fold the comic.
13. Cut strips through an index card and thread comic through.
14. Use for nonlinguistic representation.
15. Use for contextual synonyms.
16. Tell a visual story.
17. Break words apart into components.
18. Many uses!

Use the size of each comic frame to gauge the size of the cuts and their spacing.



Don't enlarge your comic TOO big, or it will pixelate and become grainy. This is especially important if you have words in your Comic Strip.
